Projects: Over the last 12 months, we have worked on a wide range of projects. These are just some of those:

- 1 150 place Ysgol Treferthyr, Criccieth completed for 2 Llys Awelon Extra Care scheme in Ruthin, Denbighshire, Cyngor Gwynedd in September 2024. The project provides a modern learning environment under the Welsh Government's 21st Century Schools Programme.
- 3 Completed in March 2024, Rosemount Avenue in Preesall allowed AGa to continue working with Lovell Partnership to provide 42 new dwellings for affordable rent in partnership with Jigsaw Homes.
- 5 3-23 Edward Henry Street completed for Clwyd Alyn. Located within the Rhyl Central Conservation Area, the scheme provided 13 three-bedroom affordable family homes constructed as part of the Targeted Regeneration Investment Programme (TRIP).
- 7 Works commenced in Autumn 2024 on the refurbishment of 42-50 Nevill Street, to create six new dwellings at first and second floor, bringing back to life a historical building in Southport.
- 9 39 affordable homes for Pobl handed over in Ladyhill, Newport, built to SAP 100 & EPC A rating using Modern Methods of Construction, using Sevenoaks Modular panelised, pre-insulated timber frame construction.

- handed over November 2024, providing an additional 35no. self-contained one and two bed apartments with 24-hour care for Grwp Ceynfin.
- AGa gained planning approval for 8 new dwellings at Martin Close, Irby, on behalf of a private client in December 2024. The scheme makes use of an infill site to provide new housing in a residential area.
- Another project completed with Lovell Partnership in 2024 was Bonscale Crescent, Middleton, Manchester. This site was another phase of work carried out in the area alongside Lovell, providing 57 new homes with green space and play areas as part of the proposals.
- Penyffridd, Bangor for Adra was handed over in November 2024, comprising 30 new quality energyefficient homes built using natural, sustainable materials and greener technologies.
- 10 Completed in Summer 2024, the project at 244 Allerton Rd, Liverpool involved the demolition of an existing building being replaced with 2 no. new 5 bedroom detached homes for Hampton Developments.
